Our region saw the second-highest rate of growth in life sciences jobs in the country over the last five years—bringing our market into the top 10 for national research talent. The strength of the industry in the United States continues to grow: In 2022, research professions increased by 3.1% to a record 545,000 specialists.²

Record-breaking healthcare funding

In 2022, Colorado raised more than \$1.6 billion and pulled in more than \$550 million in federal grants.³ In the same year, Colorado placed among the top 20 states for NIH funding.¹ Here, purpose–driven organizations can fund their missions in our thriving, \$75 billion startup ecosystem.⁴

Denver International Airport (DEN) served 69.3 million passengers in 2022, making it the third busiest airport in the world.⁵ With 23 airlines, 181 nonstop destinations in the United States and 28 nonstop international destinations as of December 2023^{6,7} DEN offers immediate access to global multimodal transport networks and supply chains—and connects industry leaders, manufacturers and innovators with the global community.
